1 **SECTION 1. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY RESEARCH, DEVELOP-**
2 **MENT, TESTING, AND EVALUATION OF**
3 **NOVEL TECHNOLOGIES TO DETECT**
4 **FENTANYL VAPOR OR PARTICLES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Department of
6 Energy Research and Innovation Act (42 U.S.C. 18641
7 et seq.) is amended by—

8 (1) by redesignating section 317 (42 U.S.C.
9 18655) as section 318; and

10 (2) by inserting after section 316 the following
11 new section:

12 **“SEC. 317. RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, TESTING, AND EVAL-**
13 **UATION OF NOVEL TECHNOLOGIES TO DE-**
14 **TECT FENTANYL VAPOR OR PARTICLES.**

15 “The Secretary of Energy, in coordination with the
16 Attorney General, the Secretary of Homeland Security,
17 and the Postmaster General, shall carry out a research,
18 development, testing, and evaluation program of novel
19 technologies to detect fentanyl vapor or particles in sup-
20 port of rapid screening—

21 “(1) of the mails;

22 “(2) at prisons;

23 “(3) at United States borders; and

24 “(4) in other related use cases.”.

25 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
26 in section 1(b) of the Department of Energy Research and

- 1 Innovation Act is amended by striking the item relating
- 2 to section 317 and inserting the following new items:

“Sec. 317. Research, development, testing, and evaluation of novel technologies
to detect fentanyl vapor or particles.

“Sec. 318. Authorization of appropriations.”.
