A BILL

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act to eliminate the general Medicaid funding limitations for territories of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid Improvement
5 for Insular Areas Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF GENERAL MEDICAID FUNDING**
7 **LIMITATIONS (“CAP”) FOR TERRITORIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1108 of the Social Secu-
9 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1308) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (f), in the matter preceding
 2 paragraph (1), by striking “subsections (g) and (h)”
 3 and inserting “subsections (g), (h), and (j)”;

4 (2) in subsection (g)(2), in the matter pre-
 5 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “and para-
 6 graphs (3), (5), and (14)” and inserting “, para-
 7 graphs (3), (5), and (14), and subsection (j)”;

8 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
 9 section:

10 “(j) SUNSET OF MEDICAID FUNDING LIMITA-
 11 TIONS.—Subsections (f) and (g) shall not apply to Puerto
 12 Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, the Northern Mariana Is-
 13 lands, and American Samoa beginning with fiscal year
 14 2025.”.

15 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

16 (1) Section 1902(j) of the Social Security Act
 17 (42 U.S.C. 1396a(j)) is amended by striking “, the
 18 limitation in section 1108(f),”.

19 (2) Section 1903(u) of the Social Security Act
 20 (42 U.S.C. 1396b(u)) is amended by striking para-
 21 graph (4).

22 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 23 this section shall apply beginning with fiscal year 2025.

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
