A BILL

To limit funds to the United Nations and other organizations that provide any status, rights, or privileges beyond observer status to the Palestine Liberation Organization, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Official Palestine
5 Entry Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION WITH RESPECT TO MEMBERSHIP OF**
2 **PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION IN**
3 **UNITED NATIONS AGENCIES.**

4 Section 414(a) of the Foreign Relations Authoriza-
5 tion Act, Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 (22 U.S.C. 287e
6 note; Public Law 101–246) is amended by striking “the
7 same standing as member states” and inserting “any sta-
8 tus, rights, or privileges beyond observer status”.

9 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO LIMITATIONS ON CONTRIBU-**
10 **TIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS AND AFFILI-**
11 **ATED ORGANIZATIONS.**

12 Section 410 of the Foreign Relations Authorization
13 Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995 (22 U.S.C. 287e note;
14 Public Law 103–236) is amended by striking “full mem-
15 bership” each place it appears and inserting “any status,
16 rights, or privileges beyond observer status”.

17 **SEC. 4. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

18 Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to Tai-
19 wan.
