Mr. MRVAN (for himself and Mrs. KIGGANS of Virginia) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to report annually on compensation for police officers of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans’ Security and
5 Pay Transparency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ANNUAL REPORT ON COMPENSATION FOR POLICE**
2 **OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VET-**
3 **ERANS AFFAIRS.**

4 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Chapter 9 of title 38, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6 lowing new section:

7 **“§ 906. Annual report on compensation for Depart-**
8 **ment police officers**

9 “(a) REQUIREMENT.—Not less than once each cal-
10 endar year, the Secretary shall submit to the Committees
11 on Veterans’ Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-
12 resentatives a report on compensation paid to Department
13 police officers. Each such report shall include the following
14 elements, disaggregated by facility of the Department and
15 positions described in subsection (b):

16 “(1) Salaries.

17 “(2) Availability pay under section 5545a of
18 title 5.

19 “(3) Bonuses to recruit or retain Department
20 police officers.

21 “(4) Any other compensation paid to a Depart-
22 ment police officer.

23 “(b) POSITIONS.—A position described in this sub-
24 section is a position in the following series (or successor
25 classifications) of the General Schedule:

26 “(1) Chief of Police (GS–0080).

1 “(2) Deputy Chief of Police (GS–0080).

2 “(3) Supervisory Police Officer (GS–0083).

3 “(4) Criminal Investigator (GS–1811).

4 “(5) Police Detective (GS–0083).

5 “(6) Police Officer (GS–0083).

6 “(7) Training Officer (GS–0083).

7 “(8) Physical Security Specialist (GS–0080).

8 “(9) Security Specialist Assistant (GS–0086).

9 “(10) Dispatcher (GS–0086).

10 “(11) Administrative Officer (GS–0303 or GS–
11 0341).”.

12 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
13 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
14 at the end the following new item:

“906. Annual report on compensation for Department police officers.”.

15 (c) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Secretary of Veterans
16 Affairs shall submit the first report under section 906 of
17 such title, as added by this section, not later than six
18 months after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
