A BILL

To prohibit chief executive officers convicted of covered
crimes from serving in the executive branch, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Corporate Crooks
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTION ON SERVICE IN THE EXECUTIVE**
7 **BRANCH.**

8 (a) RESTRICTION.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Any individual who served
2 or was employed as a chief executive officer at an
3 entity and was finally convicted of a covered crime
4 shall be ineligible for appointment to a position in
5 the executive branch.

6 (2) COVERED CRIME DEFINED.—The term
7 “covered crime” means any of the following:

8 (A) Bribery.

9 (B) Copyright infringement.

10 (C) Corruption.

11 (D) Cybercrime.

12 (E) Embezzlement.

13 (F) Fraud.

14 (G) Insider trading.

15 (H) Wage theft.

16 (I) Tax evasion.

17 (b) PENALTY.—Any individual found in violation of
18 this section shall be removed from service or employment
19 in the executive branch.

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
