A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Government from establishing or maintaining a database that contains data collected through, or facilitates, the biometric identity verification of a citizen of the United States, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN FEDERAL GOVERN-**
4 **MENT DATABASES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—An agency of the Federal Govern-
6 ment may not establish or maintain a database that con-
7 tains data collected through, or facilitates, the biometric
8 identity verification of a citizen of the United States.

1 (b) BIOMETRIC IDENTITY VERIFICATION DE-
2 FINED.—In this section, the term “biometric identity
3 verification” means the automated recognition of an indi-
4 vidual based on the biological or behavioral characteristics
5 of such individual from which distinguishing, repeatable
6 biometric features are extracted, including fingerprints,
7 iris patterns, or facial features.
