Mr. GREEN of Tennessee introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To prohibit Federal service academies from providing training and education based on critical race theory or diversity, equity, and inclusion.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Focusing Academies
5 on Leadership and Cultivating Officers for National Secu-
6 rity Act” or the “FALCONS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON TRAINING AND EDUCATION AT**
2 **FEDERAL SERVICE ACADEMIES REGARDING**
3 **CRITICAL RACE THEORY, DIVERSITY, EQUITY,**
4 **AND INCLUSION.**

5 No Federal funds may be obligated or expended to
6 establish a curriculum, or to provide training or education
7 based on critical race theory, diversity, equity, and inclu-
8 sion at any of the following institutions:

- 9 (1) The United States Military Academy.
10 (2) The United States Naval Academy.
11 (3) The United States Air Force Academy.
12 (4) The United States Coast Guard Academy.
13 (5) The United States Merchant Marine Acad-
14 emy.
