A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Energy to restrict certain grants to any State that has in effect a law prohibiting hydraulic fracturing within such State, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom to Frack
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON HYDRAULIC FRACTURING.**

7 Section 545(c) of the Energy Independence and Secu-
8 rity Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 17155) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

1 “(6) INELIGIBILITY.—A State may not be eligi-
2 ble for a grant under the program if such State es-
3 tablishes or continues to enforce a prohibition of hy-
4 draulic fracturing, as defined in section 60.5430a of
5 title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (or any suc-
6 cessor regulation), within such State.”.
