A BILL

To amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to prohibit feeding sharks in the exclusive economic zone off the State of Florida.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Florida Safe Seas Act
5 of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEEDING SHARKS IN EXCLUSIVE**
7 **ECONOMIC ZONE OFF STATE OF FLORIDA.**

8 Section 317 of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Con-
9 servation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1866) is
10 amended—

11 (1) by striking “the State” and inserting “the
12 States”; and

13 (2) by inserting “and Florida” after “Hawaii”.
