1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Non-Discrimination Home Rule Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF APPLICABILITY OF RELIGIOUS**
7 **FREEDOM RESTORATION ACT TO THE DIS-**
8 **TRICT OF COLUMBIA.**

10 Restoration Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 2000bb–2(2)) is
