2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Combating Overregula-
5 tion And Limitation of Proven, Operable, Working Energy
6 Resources Act” or the “COAL POWER Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF EPA RULE.**

2 The final rule issued by the Environmental Protec-
3 tion Agency titled “National Emission Standards for Haz-
4 ardous Air Pollutants: Coal- and Oil-Fired Electric Utility
5 Steam Generating Units Review of the Residual Risk and
6 Technology Review” (89 Fed. Reg. 38508 (May 7, 2024))
7 shall have no force or effect and shall be treated as if such
8 rule had never taken effect.

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
