AN ACT

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to reauthorize the National Estuary Program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Enhancing Science,
- 3 Treatment, and Upkeep of America's Resilient and Impor-
- 4 tant Estuarine Systems Act" or the "ESTUARIES Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. NATIONAL ESTUARY PROGRAM.
- 6 Section 320 of the Federal Water Pollution Control
- 7 Act (33 U.S.C. 1330) is amended—
- 8 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(B), by striking "and
- 9 Pensacola and Perdido Bays, Florida" and inserting
- 10 "Pensacola and Perdido Bays, Florida; and Mis-
- sissippi Sound, Mississippi"; and
- 12 (2) in subsection (i)(1), in the matter preceding
- subparagraph (A), by striking "2026" and inserting
- 14 "2031".
- 15 SEC. 3. INELIGIBILITY WITH RESPECT TO FISCAL YEARS
- 16 **2025 AND 2026.**
- 17 With respect to the amendment made by section 2(1),
- 18 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-
- 19 cy may not use for the implementation of that amendment,
- 20 including, with respect to Mississippi Sound, Mississippi,
- 21 convening a management conference, developing or car-
- 22 rying out a comprehensive conservation and management
- 23 plan, or providing grants under section 320 of the Federal
- 24 Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1330)—

1	(1) any amounts appropriated to carry out the
2	national estuary program under that section for fis-
3	cal year 2025; or

4 (2) unless the total amount appropriated to carry out that program for fiscal year 2026 is at least \$850,000 more than the total amount appropriated to carry out that program for fiscal year 2024, any amounts appropriated to carry out that program for fiscal year 2026.
