A BILL

To amend section 235 of the Immigration and Nationality Act to remove certain exceptions with respect to the inspection of applicants for admission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Expedited Removal
5 Expansion Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. INSPECTION OF APPLICANTS FOR ADMISSION.**

7 Section 235(b)(1) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1225(b)(1)) is amended in—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) in clause (i)—

2 (i) by striking “(other than an alien
3 described in subparagraph (F))”; and

4 (ii) by striking “under section
5 212(a)(6)(C) or 212(a)(7),” and inserting
6 “under section 212”;

7 (B) in clause (ii)—

8 (i) by striking “(other than an alien
9 described in subparagraph (F))”; and

10 (ii) by striking “under section
11 212(a)(6)(C) or 212(a)(7)” and inserting
12 “under section 212”; and

13 (C) in clause (iii)(II)—

14 (i) by striking “who is not described
15 in subparagraph (F),”; and

16 (ii) by striking “, and who has not af-
17 firmatively shown, to the satisfaction of an
18 immigration officer, that the alien has been
19 physically present in the United States
20 continuously for the 2-year period imme-
21 diately prior to the date of the determina-
22 tion of inadmissibility under this subpara-
23 graph”;

24 (2) by striking subparagraph (F); and

- 1 (3) by redesignating subparagraph (G) as sub-
- 2 paragraph (F).
