A BILL

To amend title 4, United States Code, to allow for cemetery flags to be displayed in an upright position directly adjacent to the grave sites of deceased members of the Armed Forces or veterans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Flags to
5 Honor Our Veterans Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. CEMETERY FLAGS.**

2 Section 6 of title 4, United States Code, is amended
3 by adding at the end the following:

4 “(h) Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-
5 tion, the flag may be displayed in a secured, upright posi-
6 tion directly adjacent to the grave site of a deceased mem-
7 ber of the Armed Forces (as defined in section 101 of title
8 10) or veteran (as defined in section 101 of title 38).”.
