3 **SECTION 1. CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION FOR CERTAIN FOR-**
4 **EST MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES IN YOSEMITE**
5 **NATIONAL PARK.**

6 (a) CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION ESTABLISHED.—The
7 forest management activities described in subsection (b)
8 are a category of activities hereby designated as being cat-

1 egorically excluded from the preparation of an environ-
2 mental assessment or an environmental impact statement
3 under section 102 of the National Environmental Policy
4 Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4332).

5 (b) FOREST MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES DESIGNATED
6 FOR CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION.—The forest management
7 activities designated under subsection (a) for a categorical
8 exclusion are—

9 (1) the planning, approval, and execution of
10 fuels removal activities, including brush removal ac-
11 tivities, in Yosemite National Park; and

12 (2) the planning, approval, and execution of re-
13 forestation activities in Yosemite National Park.
