A BILL

To prohibit participation of persons convicted of certain felonies in programs of the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Funding Rioters
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERSONS CONVICTED OF CERTAIN FELONIES IN-**
7 **ELIGIBLE FOR SMALL BUSINESS ADMINIS-**
8 **TRATION ASSISTANCE.**

9 No person convicted of an offense relating to a mis-
10 demeanor or felony assault of a law enforcement officer,

1 or convicted of a felony for actions during or in connection
2 with a riot that resulted in the destruction of a small busi-
3 ness concern (as defined in section 3 of the Small Business
4 Act (15 U.S.C. 632)), shall be eligible to receive any as-
5 sistance from or through, or participate in, any program
6 administered by the Small Business Administration.
