A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to identify existing and potential categorical exclusions related to the production and export of coal.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining NEPA
5 for Coal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IDENTIFICATION OF EXISTING AND POTENTIAL**
7 **CATEGORICAL EXCLUSIONS RELATED TO**
8 **THE PRODUCTION AND EXPORT OF COAL.**

9 Not later than 30 days after the date of enactment
10 of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall identify to

1 the Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-
2 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Natural
3 Resources of the Senate any existing and potential cat-
4 egorical exclusions pursuant to the National Environ-
5 mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.), in-
6 creased reliance on and adoption of which by other Fed-
7 eral agencies pursuant to section 109 of the National En-
8 vironmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4336c) could
9 further the production and export of coal.

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
