A BILL

To amend chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, to provide for additional time for Congress to disapprove of rules.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Review
5 Reform Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW**
2 **ACT.**

3 Chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, is amended
4 as follows:

5 (1) In section 801—

6 (A) by striking subsection (d); and

7 (B) by redesignating subsections (e)
8 through (g) as subsections (d) through (f), re-
9 spectively.

10 (2) In section 802—

11 (A) in subsection (a), to read as follows:

12 “(a) For purposes of this section, the term ‘joint res-
13 olution’ means only a joint resolution introduced after the
14 report referred to in section 801(a)(1)(A) is received by
15 Congress, the matter after the resolving clause of which
16 is as follows: ‘That Congress disapproves the rule sub-
17 mitted by the _____ relating to _____, and such
18 rule shall have no force or effect.’ (The blank spaces being
19 appropriately filled in).”;

20 (B) by striking subsection (e); and

21 (C) by redesignating subsections (f) and
22 (g) as subsections (e) and (f), respectively.

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
