## A BILL

To provide penalties for certain misconduct by officers and members of the board of directors of nonprofit entities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Tax Dollars for  
5 Riots”.

1 **SEC. 2. PENALTIES RELATED TO CERTAIN MISCONDUCT BY**  
2 **OFFICERS OF NONPROFIT ENTITIES.**

3 (a) LIMITATION ON FEDERAL FUNDING.—No Fed-  
4 eral funds may be made available to an entity that is ex-  
5 empt from taxation under section 501 of the Internal Rev-  
6 enue Code of 1986 if an officer of such entity or member  
7 of the board of directors of such entity is convicted of an  
8 offense under section 111 or 2101 of title 18, United  
9 States Code, and the conduct giving rise to the offense  
10 occurred while such individual was serving as such an offi-  
11 cer or board member.

12 (b) LIMITATION ON EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION.—  
13 An entity that is exempt from taxation under section 501  
14 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall be ineligible  
15 for such exemption beginning on the date on which an offi-  
16 cer of such entity or member of the board of directors  
17 of such entity is convicted of an offense under section 111  
18 or 2101 of title 18, United States Code, and the conduct  
19 giving rise to the offense occurred while such individual  
20 was serving as such an officer or board member.
