Mr. McDOWELL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the 21st Century Cures Act to improve the administration, oversight, and impact of opioid use disorder grants, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Clarity for Opioid-Use
5 Reduction and Expenditures Act” or the “CURE Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPROVING ADMINISTRATION, OVERSIGHT, AND IM-**
7 **PACT OF OPIOID USE DISORDER GRANTS.**

8 (a) ACCOUNTABILITY AND OVERSIGHT.—Subsection
9 (c) of section 1003 of the 21st Century Cures Act (42
10 U.S.C. 290ee–3a) is amended to read as follows:

1 “(c) ACCOUNTABILITY AND OVERSIGHT.—

2 “(1) STANDARDIZED SYSTEM FOR DATA COL-
3 LECTION.—The Secretary shall develop and imple-
4 ment a standardized system for collecting data from
5 States receiving grants under subsection (b).

6 “(2) SUBMISSION OF DATA.—A State receiving
7 a grant under subsection (b) shall submit to the Sec-
8 retary, through the standardized system referred to
9 in paragraph (1), on a quarterly basis, a description
10 of—

11 “(A) the purposes for which the grant
12 funds received by the State under such sub-
13 section for the preceding fiscal year were ex-
14 pended and a description of the activities of the
15 State under the grant;

16 “(B) the ultimate recipients of amounts
17 provided to the State, including the name, loca-
18 tion, and taxpayer identification number of any
19 grant subrecipients;

20 “(C) the number of individuals served
21 through the grant; and

22 “(D) such other information as determined
23 appropriate by the Secretary.

24 “(3) USE OF OTHER FEDERAL GRANT-TRACK-
25 ING SYSTEMS.—The Secretary shall, in collecting

1 data through the standardized system referred to in
2 paragraph (1), to the extent feasible, make use of
3 other Federal grant-tracking systems to avoid dupli-
4 cation of efforts.”.

5 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Section 1003(f) of the
6 21st Century Cures Act (42 U.S.C. 290ee–3a(f)) is
7 amended—

8 (1) by amending paragraph (2) to read as fol-
9 lows:

10 “(2) the activities of the recipients and sub-
11 recipients of the grants; and”; and

12 (2) by amending paragraph (3) to read as fol-
13 lows:

14 “(3) each entity that receives a grant or is a
15 subrecipient of a grant under this section, including
16 the funding level provided to such recipient or sub-
17 recipient.”.

18 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
19 sections (a) and (b) shall apply beginning 180 days after
20 the date of enactment of this Act.

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
