A BILL

To continue the pause on disbursements and new financing
commitments to the Government of Burma.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “No New Burma Funds*
5 *Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUATION OF PAUSE ON WORLD BANK DIS-**
7 **BURSEMENTS AND COMMITMENTS TO**
8 **BURMA.**

9 *The Secretary of the Treasury shall direct the United*
10 *States Executive Director at the International Bank for Re-*
11 *construction and Development to use the voice and vote of*
12 *the United States to continue the pause by the Bank on*
13 *disbursements and the making of new financing commit-*
14 *ments to the Government of Burma, that was initiated after*
15 *a military coup overthrew the democratically elected Gov-*
16 *ernment of Burma in 2021, unless the Secretary of the*
17 *Treasury determines that it is not in the national interest*
18 *to do so.*
