Mr. CARTER of Georgia (for himself, Mr. LAWLER, Mr. CROW, and Mr. HARDER of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

## A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a Veterans Health Care Stamp.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Health Care  
5       Stamp Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. VETERANS HEALTH CARE STAMP.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—In order to afford a convenient  
8       way for members of the public to contribute to funding  
9       for the medical care and treatment of veterans, the United

1 States Postal Service shall provide for the issuance and  
2 sale of a special postage stamp which shall be known as  
3 the “Veterans Health Care Stamp”.

4 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The issuance and sale  
5 of the Veterans Health Care Stamp shall be governed by  
6 section 416 of title 39, United States Code (as last in ef-  
7 fect, if expired), except that—

8 (1) all amounts becoming available from the  
9 sale of the stamp shall be transferred to the Depart-  
10 ment of Veterans Affairs in accordance with section  
11 416(d) of such title; and

12 (2) the stamp—

13 (A) shall be issued in time for Veterans  
14 Day of each year;

15 (B) shall bear such illustration, depiction,  
16 design, or other image as the United States  
17 Postal Service shall determine; and

18 (C) shall not be subject to any numerical  
19 limitation under section 416(e)(1)(C) of such  
20 title.
