A BILL

To amend the Energy Conservation and Production Act to repeal certain Federal building energy efficiency performance standards, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reliable Federal infra-
5 structure Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REVISED FEDERAL BUILDING ENERGY**
2 **EFFICIENCY PERFORMANCE STANDARDS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—

4 (1) REPEAL.—Section 305(a)(3) of the Energy
5 Conservation and Production Act (42 U.S.C.
6 6834(a)(3)) is amended by striking subparagraph
7 (D).

8 (2) STANDARDS.—Each revised Federal build-
9 ing energy efficiency performance standard estab-
10 lished under section 305(a)(3)(D) of the Energy
11 Conservation and Production Act (42 U.S.C.
12 6834(a)(3)(D)) (as in effect on the day before the
13 date of enactment of this Act) shall have no force
14 or effect, and section 305(a)(3) of the Energy Con-
15 servation and Production Act (42 U.S.C.
16 6834(a)(3)) shall be implemented as though each
17 such standard had never taken effect.

18 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

19 (1) STANDARDS.—Section 433 of the Energy
20 Independence and Security Act of 2007 (Public Law
21 110–140) is amended by striking subsection (a).

22 (2) HIGH-PERFORMANCE GREEN FEDERAL
23 BUILDINGS.—Section 436 of the Energy Independ-
24 ence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 17092) is
25 amended—

26 (A) in subsection (c)—

1 (i) by striking paragraph (1); and

2 (ii) in paragraph (6), by striking “and
3 section 305(a)(3)(D) of the Energy Con-
4 servation and Production Act (42 U.S.C.
5 6834(a)(3)(D))”;

6 (B) in subsection (e), by striking “in ac-
7 cordance with the requirements of section
8 305(a)(3)(D) of the Energy Conservation and
9 Production Act (42 U.S.C. 6834(a)(3)(D)),”;

10 (C) in subsection (f)—

11 (i) in paragraph (1)—

12 (I) in the matter preceding sub-
13 paragraph (A), by striking “, the re-
14 quirements of section 305(a)(3)(D) of
15 the Energy Conservation and Produc-
16 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 6834(a)(3)(D)),”;

17 and

18 (II) in subparagraph (A), by
19 striking “and the requirements of sec-
20 tion 305(a)(3)(D) of that Act”; and

21 (ii) by striking paragraph (2); and

22 (D) by striking subsection (h).

23 (3) FEDERAL GREEN BUILDING PERFORM-
24 ANCE.—Section 437(a)(1) of the Energy Independ-
25 ence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C.

1 17093(a)(1)) is amended by striking “, section
2 305(a)(3)(D) of the Energy Conservation and Pro-
3 duction Act (42 U.S.C. 6834(a)(3)(D)),”.

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
