## A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of duties on certain baby toy items pursuant to the International Emergency Economic Powers Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educational Toy Tax  
5 Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF DUTIES ON CER-**  
2 **TAIN BABY TOY ITEMS PURSUANT TO THE**  
3 **INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY ECONOMIC**  
4 **POWERS ACT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
6 sion of law, the President—

7 (1) may not impose duties on the items de-  
8 scribed in section 3 pursuant to the International  
9 Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701  
10 et seq.); and

11 (2) shall terminate the imposition of duties on  
12 the items described in section 3 pursuant to the  
13 International Emergency Economic Powers Act that  
14 are in effect as of the date of the enactment of this  
15 Act.

16 (b) DUTIES UNDER OTHER AUTHORITIES.—Any du-  
17 ties imposed by the President on the items described in  
18 section 3 pursuant to any other authority that are sub-  
19 stantially similar to the duties imposed pursuant to the  
20 International Emergency Economic Powers Act shall have  
21 no force or effect.

22 **SEC. 3. ITEMS DESCRIBED.**

23 The items described in this section are the following:

24 (1) Products for children under the age of  
25 three.

- 1           (2) Tricycles, scooters, and pedal cars for ba-
- 2       bies and children.
- 3           (3) Playpens, play yards, and enclosures.
- 4           (4) Baby swings.
- 5           (5) Educational toys for babies and children.
