A BILL

To expand the sharing of information with respect to suspected violations of intellectual property rights in trade.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHARING OF INFORMATION WITH RESPECT TO**
 4 **SUSPECTED VIOLATIONS OF INTELLECTUAL**
 5 **PROPERTY RIGHTS.**

6 *Section 628A of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.*
 7 *1628a) is amended—*

8 *(1) in subsection (a)—*

9 *(A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),*
 10 *by striking “suspects” and inserting “has a rea-*
 11 *sonable suspicion”;*

12 *(B) in paragraph (1)—*

13 *(i) by inserting “, packing materials,*
 14 *containers,” after “its packaging” the first*
 15 *place it appears;*

16 *(ii) by striking “and its packaging*
 17 *and labels” after “images of the merchan-*
 18 *dise” and inserting “, its packaging, pack-*
 19 *ing materials, containers, and labels”; and*

20 *(iii) by striking “; and” and inserting*
 21 *a semicolon;*

22 *(C) in paragraph (2), by striking the period*
 23 *and inserting a semicolon; and*

24 *(D) by adding at the end the following:*

1 “(3) may provide to the person nonpublic infor-
2 mation about the merchandise that was generated by
3 an online marketplace or other similar market plat-
4 form, express consignment operator, freight forwarder,
5 or any other entity that plays a role in the sale or
6 importation of merchandise, or the facilitation there-
7 of, into the United States that has been provided to,
8 shared with, or obtained by U.S. Customs and Border
9 Protection; and

10 “(4) in the case of the provision of nonpublic in-
11 formation described in paragraph (3), shall provide
12 to the person notification of the information trans-
13 mitted, in accordance with such regulations as the
14 Secretary may prescribe.”; and

15 (2) in subsection (b)—

16 (A) in paragraph (3), by striking “; and”
17 and inserting a semicolon;

18 (B) in paragraph (4), by striking the period
19 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

20 (C) by adding at the end the following:

21 “(5) any other party with an interest in the
22 merchandise, as determined appropriate by the Com-
23 missioner.”.

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
