1 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION TO DEMONSTRATION AND**
2 **PROTOTYPING PROGRAM TO ADVANCE**
3 **INTERNATIONAL PRODUCT SUPPORT CAPA-**
4 **BILITIES IN A CONTESTED LOGISTICS ENVI-**
5 **RONMENT.**

6 Section 842 of the National Defense Authorization
7 Act for Fiscal Year 2024 (Public Law 118–31; 10 U.S.C.
8 2341 note) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (b)(2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking
11 “and” at the end;

12 (B) by redesignating subparagraph (B) as
13 subparagraph (C); and

14 (C) by inserting after subparagraph (A)
15 the following new subparagraph:

16 “(B) commercial additive manufacturing
17 facilities for rapid, distributed production of
18 parts closer to the point of use; and”; and

19 (2) in subsection (g), by striking “on the date”
20 and all that follows and inserting “December 31,
21 2030.”.

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
