To prohibit Federal funding for entities that employ individuals who condone and celebrate political violence and domestic terrorism, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITING FEDERAL FUNDING FOR ENTI-**
4 **TIES THAT EMPLOY INDIVIDUALS WHO CON-**
5 **DONE AND CELEBRATE POLITICAL VIOLENCE**
6 **AND DOMESTIC TERRORISM.**

7 No Federal funds may be obligated, expended, or oth-
8 erwise disbursed to any entity that employ individuals who
9 condone and celebrate political violence and domestic ter-

1 rorism (as that term is defined in section 2331 of title
2 18, United States Code).

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
