A BILL

To ensure an evidence-based funding approach to study the effects of health profession opportunity grant demonstration projects, and to evaluate the demonstration projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Impacts and Outcomes
5 for Health Career Training Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EVIDENCE-BASED FUNDING APPROACH TO STUDY**
2 **THE EFFECTS OF HEALTH PROFESSION OP-**
3 **PORTUNITY GRANT DEMONSTRATION**
4 **PROJECTS; EVALUATION OF DEMONSTRA-**
5 **TION PROJECTS.**

6 Section 2008 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1397g) is amended—

8 (1) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
9 subsections (d) and (e), respectively; and

10 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(c) STUDY.—

13 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall con-
14 duct a study of the short-, medium-, and long-term
15 impacts of the demonstration projects for which a
16 grant is made under this section, including the em-
17 ployment and earnings of project participants.

18 “(2) FUNDING.—The Secretary shall use not
19 less than 4 percent of total amount made available
20 to carry out this section for each fiscal year for the
21 study required by paragraph (1), evaluations, and
22 associated staffing, for the purpose of supporting the
23 rigorous evaluation of the demonstration projects,
24 and supporting the continued study of the short-,
25 medium-, and long-term effects of all such projects,

1 including the effectiveness of new or added elements
2 of the demonstration projects.”.

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
5 on October 1, 2025.
