A BILL

To nullify Presidential Proclamation 10606, establishing Baaj Nwaavjo I'tah Kukveni-Ancestral Footprints of the Grand Canyon National Monument and withdrawing certain land in Arizona from mineral entry, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Northern Arizona Pro-
5 tection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTION ON USE OF ANTIQUITIES ACT IN CER-**
2 **TAIN AREAS IN ARIZONA.**

3 (a) NULLIFICATION OF PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMA-
4 TION.—Presidential Proclamation 10606 of August 8,
5 2023 (88 Fed. Reg. 55331, relating to the establishment
6 of the Baaj Nwaavjo I'tah Kukveni-Ancestral Footprints
7 of the Grand Canyon National Monument), shall have no
8 force or effect.

9 (b) RESTRICTION ON FUTURE MONUMENT DESIGNA-
10 TIONS.—No extension or establishment of national monu-
11 ments within the area generally depicted as “Baaj
12 Nwaavjo I'tah Kukveni-Ancestral Footprints of the Grand
13 Canyon National Monument” on the map titled “Baaj
14 Nwaavjo I'tah Kukveni-Ancestral Footprints of the Grand
15 Canyon National Monument” and dated August 5, 2023,
16 may be undertaken except by express authorization of
17 Congress.
