To amend title 10, United States Code, to require the Secretary of Defense to annually review the amount of financial assistance for child care and youth program services providers provided by the Secretary.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANNUAL REVIEW OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**
4 **LIMITS FOR CHILD CARE AND YOUTH PRO-**
5 **GRAM SERVICES PROVIDERS.**

6 Section 1798 of title 10, United States Code, is
7 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
8 section:

1 “(d) ANNUAL REVIEW OF AMOUNT OF ASSIST-
2 ANCE.—The Secretary shall annually review the amount
3 of financial assistance provided under this section, includ-
4 ing the maximum amount of financial assistance per
5 month per child that the Secretary authorizes to be pro-
6 vided to eligible providers under this section.”.
