# **A BILL**

To modify the termination of the aviation consumer protection advisory committee, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       *This Act may be cited as the “ACPAC Modernization*  
5       *Act”.*

6       **SEC. 2. AVIATION CONSUMER PROTECTION ADVISORY COM-**  
7                **MITTEE.**

8       *Section 411 of the FAA Modernization and Reform Act*  
9       *of 2012 (49 U.S.C. 42301 prec. note) is amended—*

10            *(1) in subsection (b)—*

11                    *(A) in paragraph (3) by striking “; and”*  
12                    *and inserting a semicolon;*

13                    *(B) in paragraph (4) by striking the period*  
14                    *and inserting “; and”; and*

15                    *(C) by adding at the end the following:*

16                    *“(5) ticket agents.”; and*

17                    *(2) in subsection (i) by striking “ticket agents,”.*

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
