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## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to eliminate the coinsurance requirement for certain colorectal cancer screening tests furnished under the Medicare program.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Colorectal Cancer Pay-  
5       ment Fairness Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATING THE COINSURANCE REQUIREMENT**  
2 **FOR CERTAIN COLORECTAL CANCER**  
3 **SCREENING TESTS FURNISHED UNDER THE**  
4 **MEDICARE PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1833(dd) of the Social Security Act (42  
6 U.S.C. 1395l(dd)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “and before  
8 January 1, 2030,”; and

9 (2) in paragraph (2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (A), by adding “and”  
11 at the end;

12 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking  
13 “through 2026, 85 percent; and” and inserting  
14 “and each subsequent year, 100 percent.”; and

15 (C) by striking subparagraph (C).

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
