A BILL

To reinstate all financial assistance awards terminated by
the Department of Energy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop the Trump Elec-
5 tricity Price Hikes Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REINSTATEMENT OF TERMINATED AWARDS.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all finan-
3 cial assistance awards terminated by the Department of
4 Energy pursuant to the Secretarial Memorandum entitled
5 “Ensuring Responsibility for Financial Assistance,” dated
6 May 15, 2025, shall be deemed reinstated and shall con-
7 tinue in effect as if such terminations had not occurred.

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
