A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for civilian and military public shipyard workers pay in the event of a Government shutdown.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pay Our Public Ship-
5 yard Workers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CIVILIAN AND**
7 **MILITARY PUBLIC SHIPYARD WORKERS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are hereby appropriated for
9 fiscal year 2026, out of any money in the Treasury not

1 otherwise appropriated, for any period during which in-
2 terim or full-year appropriations for fiscal year 2026 or
3 2027 are not in effect such sums as are necessary to pro-
4 vide pay and allowances to civilian and military public
5 shipyard workers who work during such period.

6 (b) TERMINATION.—Appropriations and funds made
7 available and authority granted pursuant to this Act shall
8 be available until whichever of the following first occurs:

9 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
10 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
11 pose for which amounts are made available in sub-
12 section (a).

13 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
14 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
15 other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
16 pose.

17 (3) January 1, 2027.

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
