A BILL

To reinstate exemptions to SNAP work-requirements for homeless individuals, veterans, and former foster youth.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “SNAP Back Act of
5 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE FOOD AND NUTRITION ACT**
7 **OF 2008.**

8 Section 6(o) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
9 (7 U.S.C. 2015(o)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (F) by striking “or” at the
2 end,

3 (2) in subparagraph (G) by striking the period
4 at the end, and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(H) a homeless individual;

7 “(I) a veteran; or

8 “(J) an individual who is 24 years of age
9 or younger and who was in foster care under
10 the responsibility of a State on the date of at-
11 taining 18 years of age or such higher age as
12 the State has elected under section
13 475(8)(B)(iii) of the Social Security Act (42
14 U.S.C. 675(8)(B)(iii)).”.

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
