A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to require continued periodic reports on highway-rail grade crossing safety, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Actions For Em-
5 ploying Transportation Risk Assessments and Crossing
6 Knowledge Strategies Act” or the “SAFE TRACKS Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. REPORTS ON HIGHWAY-RAIL GRADE CROSSING**
8 **SAFETY.**

9 Section 20167 of title 49, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) in paragraph (4) by striking “and” at
3 the end;

4 (B) by redesignating paragraph (5) as
5 paragraph (6); and

6 (C) by inserting after paragraph (4) the
7 following:

8 “(5) how the State will work with stakeholders,
9 including railroads operating in and across the
10 State, to reduce pedestrian fatalities, including sui-
11 cides, along railroad right of way, in consultation
12 with mental health and law enforcement agencies
13 and entities; and”; and

14 (2) in subsection (b) by inserting “and every 5
15 years thereafter,” before “the Administrator of the
16 Federal Railroad Administration”.

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
