A BILL

To direct the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to require certain reporting by power reactor licensees that use decommissioning trust funds, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reactor Expenditure
5 Accountability and Compliance Transparency Act” or the
6 “REACT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIRED REPORTING FOR POWER REACTOR LI-**
2 **CENSEES THAT USE DECOMMISSIONING**
3 **TRUST FUNDS.**

4 The Nuclear Regulatory Commission shall revise sec-
5 tion 50.82 of title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, to re-
6 quire each power reactor licensee that uses a decommis-
7 sioning trust fund to report to the Nuclear Regulatory
8 Commission in each financial assurance status report of
9 such licensee—

10 (1) any earned interest of the decommissioning
11 trust fund;

12 (2) the projected annual rate of return of the
13 decommissioning trust fund; and

14 (3) a detailed list of expenditures made for de-
15 commissioning activities using withdrawals from the
16 decommissioning trust fund.

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
