A BILL

To specify that the Council on American-Islamic Relations and similar organizations shall not be treated as described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Tax Exemptions
5 For Terror Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COUNCIL ON AMERICAN-ISLAMIC RELATIONS AND**
2 **SIMILAR ORGANIZATIONS SUBJECT TO TAX-**
3 **ATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, the Council on American-Islamic Relations,
6 or any other organization found to have ties to terrorism
7 or terrorist organizations, shall not be treated as described
8 in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply to
10 taxable years ending after the date of the enactment of
11 this Act.

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
