# **A BILL**

To authorize leases of up to 99 years for land held in  
trust for federally recognized Indian Tribes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED TRIBE LEASING AU-**  
4       **THORITY.**

5       Subsection (a) of the first section of the Act of Au-  
6       gust 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539, chapter 615; 25 U.S.C.  
7       415(a)), is amended, in the second sentence, by inserting  
8       “, land held in trust for any other Indian Tribe included  
9       on the list published by the Secretary pursuant to section  
10      104 of the Federally Recognized Indian Tribe List Act  
11      of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 5131)” after “Chehalis Reservation”.
