A BILL

To amend the Bank Secrecy Act to exempt transactions with respect to cash reward payments by crime stopper organizations from certain currency transaction reports.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CRIME STOPPER ORGANIZATIONS.**

4 Section 5313(d) of title 31, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(3) CRIME STOPPER ORGANIZATIONS.—The
7 Secretary of the Treasury shall exempt a depository
8 institution from the reporting requirements of sub-
9 section (a) with respect to a transaction between the

1 depository institution and a nonprofit organization if
2 the transaction is in connection with the nonprofit
3 organization providing a cash reward in exchange
4 for information about a crime.”.

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
