Mr. LAWLER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To extend privileges and immunities under the International
Organizations Immunities Act to the Gulf Cooperation
Council.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gulf Diplomacy Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO**
6 **GULF COOPERATION COUNCIL MISSION.**

7 The International Organizations Immunities Act (22
8 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the
9 following:

1 “GULF COOPERATION COUNCIL MISSION

2 “SEC. 18.

3 “(a) The provisions of this Act may be extended to
4 the Gulf Cooperation Council in the same manner, to the
5 same extent, and subject to the same conditions, as they
6 may be extended to a public international organization in
7 which the United States participates pursuant to any trea-
8 ty or under the authority of any Act of Congress author-
9 izing such participation or making an appropriation for
10 such participation.

11 “(b) Under such terms and conditions as the Presi-
12 dent shall determine, consistent with the purposes of this
13 Act, the President is authorized to extend, or enter into
14 an agreement to extend, to the Gulf Cooperation Council,
15 and to its members, the privileges and immunities enjoyed
16 by diplomatic missions accredited to the United States,
17 and by members of such missions, subject to cor-
18 responding conditions and obligations.”.

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
