A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to establish additional factors considered in the design of pathways in the Transition Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transition Improve-
5 ment by Estimating Risk Act of 2025” or the “TIER Act
6 of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL FACTORS IN THE DESIGN OF PATH-**
2 **WAYS IN THE TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PRO-**
3 **GRAM.**

4 Section 1142(c)(1) of title 10, United States Code,
5 is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subparagraph (M) as sub-
7 paragraph (Q); and

8 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (L) the fol-
9 lowing new subparagraphs:

10 “(M) Child care requirements of the member
11 (including whether a dependent of the member is en-
12 rolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program).

13 “(N) The employment status of other adults in
14 the household of the member.

15 “(O) The location of the duty station of the
16 member (including whether the member was sepa-
17 rated from family while on duty).

18 “(P) The effects of operating tempo and per-
19 sonnel tempo on the member and the household of
20 the member.”.

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
