A BILL

To amend the National Science Foundation Authorization Act of 2002 and the Research and Development, Competition, and Innovation Act to repeal cost-sharing with respect to the Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Boosting the Rural
5 STEM Pipeline Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF COST-SHARING WITH RESPECT TO THE**
2 **ROBERT NOYCE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP**
3 **PROGRAM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 10A of the National
5 Science Foundation Authorization Act of 2002 (42 U.S.C.
6 1862n–1a) is amended—

7 (1) by striking subsection (i); and

8 (2) by redesignating subsections (j) and (k) as
9 subsections (i) and (j), respectively.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 10320 of
11 the Research and Development, Competition, and Innova-
12 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 18998) is amended—

13 (1) in subsection (a)—

14 (A) by striking “requirements” and insert-
15 ing “requirement”;

16 (B) by striking “forthe” and inserting “for
17 the”; and

18 (C) by striking “and under” and all that
19 follows through “are” and inserting “is”; and

20 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “waivers”
21 each place it appears and inserting “waiver”.

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
