A BILL

To amend the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 to reauthorize brownfields revitalization funding, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Brownfields Reauthor-
5 ization Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. BROWNFIELDS REVITALIZATION FUNDING.**

2 Section 104(k) of the Comprehensive Environmental
3 Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42
4 U.S.C. 9604(k)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (3)(A)(ii), by striking
6 “\$500,000” and all that follows through the period
7 at the end and inserting “\$1,000,000 for each site
8 to be remediated.”; and

9 (2) in paragraph (13), by striking
10 “\$200,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019 through
11 2023” and inserting “\$250,000,000 for each of fis-
12 cal years 2026 through 2030”.

13 **SEC. 3. STATE RESPONSE PROGRAMS.**

14 Section 128(a) of the Comprehensive Environmental
15 Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42
16 U.S.C. 9628(a)) is amended—

17 (1) in paragraph (1)(B)(i), by striking “or en-
18 hance” and inserting “, enhance, or implement”;
19 and

20 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “2019
21 through 2023” and inserting “2026 through 2030”.
