A BILL

To modify the procedures for investigating claims of evasion of antidumping and countervailing duty orders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF PROCEDURES FOR INVES-**
4 **TIGATING CLAIMS OF EVASION OF ANTI-**
5 **DUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING DUTY OR-**
6 **DERS.**

7 (a) INVESTIGATIONS.—Section 517(b)(1) of the Tar-
8 iff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1517(b)) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following: “The Commissioner may also
10 self-initiate an investigation if the Commissioner has in-

1 formation that reasonably suggests that covered merchan-
2 dise has been entered into the customs territory of the
3 United States through evasion. In such case, the terms
4 and conditions that apply to the processes for allegations
5 and referrals under this section shall also apply to a proc-
6 ess for self-initiation under the preceding sentence.”.

7 (b) JUDICIAL REVIEW.—Section 517(g)(1) of the
8 Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1517(g)(1)) is amended by
9 adding at the end the following: “A person determined to
10 have entered such covered merchandise through evasion
11 may seek judicial review under this paragraph only if all
12 liquidated duties, charges, or exactions have been paid at
13 the time the judicial review is sought.”.

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
