A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
to prevent duplicate enrollments in Exchanges.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PREVENTING DUPLICATE ENROLLMENTS IN**
4 **EXCHANGES.**

5 Section 1411 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
6 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18081) is amended by adding
7 at the end the following new subsection:

1 “(j) PREVENTING DUPLICATE ENROLLMENTS.—Not
2 later than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this
3 subsection, the Secretary shall—

4 “(1) establish, as part of the program estab-
5 lished under subsection (a), a process for identifying
6 whether the social security number provided by an
7 individual who is to be covered in the individual
8 market by a qualified health plan offered through an
9 Exchange is identical to the social security number
10 of any enrollee in any Exchange under this title en-
11 rolled for the same period in which such coverage is
12 to be effective; and

13 “(2) in the case that identical social security
14 numbers are so identified under paragraph (1), take
15 such actions as are necessary to ensure that duplica-
16 tive advance payments of premium tax credits under
17 section 1412 are not made with respect to an indi-
18 vidual.”.

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
