## A BILL

To require the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to hold a technical conference on protecting residential ratepayers from increased costs associated with large loads, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Families  
5       from AI Data Center Energy Costs Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION**  
2 **TECHNICAL CONFERENCE ON INCREASED**  
3 **COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH LARGE LOADS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the  
5 date of enactment of this Act, the Federal Energy Regu-  
6 latory Commission shall hold a Commissioner-led technical  
7 conference with representatives from the Department of  
8 Energy, public utilities, transmission providers, State reg-  
9 ulators, ratepayer advocates, large loads (including data  
10 centers used for artificial intelligence models), and such  
11 other participants as the Commission determines appro-  
12 priate, on strategies and rate structures for protecting res-  
13 idential and small commercial ratepayers from increased  
14 costs associated with large loads.

15 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
16 on which the technical conference under subsection (a)  
17 concludes, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission  
18 shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce  
19 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on  
20 Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate a report con-  
21 taining recommendations and best practices resulting from  
22 such technical conference.
