To prohibit the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency from reconsidering, revising, or replacing the final rule relating to the accidental release prevention requirements of the risk management programs under the Clean Air Act.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Chemical Disaster Pre-
5 vention Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLEAN AIR ACT RISK MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.**

2 During the period that begins on the date of enact-
3 ment of this section and ends January 20, 2029, notwith-
4 standing any other provision of law, the Administrator of
5 the Environmental Protection Agency may not propose, fi-
6 nalize, or implement any action to reconsider, revise, or
7 replace the final rule titled “Accidental Release Prevention
8 Requirements: Risk Management Programs Under the
9 Clean Air Act; Safer Communities by Chemical Accident
10 Prevention” (89 Fed. Reg. 17622; March 11, 2024).
