Mr. MULLIN (for himself, Mr. TIMMONS, Mr. TONKO, and Ms. NORTON) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To permit the Chief Administrative Officer to pay salaries in or under the House of Representatives twice per month in certain cases, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Staff Salary Schedule
5 Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. UPDATING THE PROCESS FOR PAYING SALARIES OF**
7 **THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

8 Section 116(a) of the Legislative Branch Appropria-
9 tions Act, 2002 (2 U.S.C. 4551) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “The usual day” and inserting
2 “(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), the usual
3 day”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(2) When the House of Representatives next up-
6 grades its payroll system, if directed by the Committee on
7 House Administration of the House of Representatives,
8 the Chief Administrative Officer may pay salaries in or
9 under the House of Representatives twice per month, or
10 on the basis of such other schedule, as such Committee
11 may promulgate by regulation.”.

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
