Mr. BIGGS of Arizona (for himself, Mr. NEHLS, Mr. MOORE of Alabama, Mr. GROTHMAN, Mr. OGLES, Mr. OWENS, and Mrs. WAGNER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit unlawful coercion of a minor, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coercion and Sexual
5 Abuse Free Environment Act of 2025” or the “CSAFE
6 Act of 2025”.

7 **SEC. 2. UNLAWFULLY COMPELLING CHILDREN.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2422 of title 18, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 “(c)(1) Whoever, using the mail or any facility or
2 means of interstate or foreign commerce, or within the
3 special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United
4 States, intentionally compels a minor to—

5 “(A) engage in self-harm, including suicide
6 or attempted suicide;

7 “(B) commit animal crushing (as defined
8 in section 48);

9 “(C) engage in abusive or degrading non-
10 sexual conduct (whether or not physical injury
11 results);

12 “(D) engage in sexually explicit conduct,
13 as defined in section 2256(2)(A); or

14 “(E) engage in obscene speech,
15 shall be punished as provided in paragraph (2).

16 “(2) Whoever violates, attempts to violate, or
17 conspires to violate paragraph (1)—

18 “(A) shall be fined under this title, impris-
19 oned not more than 10 years, or both;

20 “(B) if serious bodily injury results, shall
21 be fined under this title, imprisoned not more
22 than 20 years, or both; or

23 “(C) if death results, shall be fined under
24 this title, imprisoned for any term of years or
25 for life, or both.

1 “(3) In this subsection, the term ‘compel’ in-
2 cludes the use of a threat, extortion, blackmail,
3 fraud, deceit, or manipulation.”.

4 (b) JUVENILE DELINQUENCY CONFORMING AMEND-
5 MENT.—Section 5032 of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “or 2241(c),” and inserting
7 “2241(c), or 2242(c),”.

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
